

Choral Conducting Masterclass with María Guinand and Junges Vokalensemble Hannover

26 – 29 September 2024, Hanover

The masterclass with María Guinand will explore different ways to approach the study of the score and prepare it so as to propose efficient ways of rehearsing, produce an adequate choral sound for the chosen work, correct diction and phrasing, and create a personal interpretation that conveys the essence and message of the music.

The purpose is to work on a varied choral repertoire, with emphasis on the music of Spanish and Latin American composers from the 16th, 20th and 21st centuries under the direction of María Guinand. Elements of choral conducting technique and body expression will be essential in this masterclass, since María Guinand gives much emphasis on a clear and expressive gestural communication with the choir, always seeking to connect the personality of the conductor with the voices of the singers. A concert in Hanover, led by the participants themselves, will conclude the masterclass on Sunday.

Master teacher:

María Guinand is a choral and orchestral conductor, college professor, teacher and leader of national and international choral projects. She specializes in Latin American Choral Music of the 20th and 21st centuries. She was awarded the 'Kulturpreis' by the Inter Naciones Foundation (1998), the 'Robert Edler Preis für Chormusik' (2000), the Helmuth Rilling Prize (2009), the Lifetime Achievement Award by the International Federation for Choral Music (2019), Lifetime Achievement Choral Award (World Youth and Children Choral Artists' Association, Honk Kong, China) (2020) and the Honorary Doctorate of the Metropolitan University, Caracas, Venezuela (2023).

Amongst her responsibilities, she has been Professor of Music and Choral Conducting at the University Simón Bolívar (Caracas, Venezuela 1976-2019), Associate Conductor of Choral Symphonic Performances of El Sistema (Caracas, Venezuela 1976-2012), Artistic Director of the program 'Música para Crecer' of the Andean Bank of Development (Latin America 2003-2017), Member of the International Music Council (UNESCO 2002-2004); Founder and artistic Director of the Cantoría Alberto Grau (1976-2012) and Orfeón Universitario Simón Bolívar (1976-2008). Furthermore she is acting Vice-President and Advisor of the International Federation for Choral Music and Member of the World Choir Council of Interkultur (since 2017).

She is frequently invited as guest conductor, adjudicator, jury member, lecturer and professor of choral music in USA, Canada, Latin America, Europe, Asia and Oceanía, and has premiered many new works. She is currently the Artistic Director of the Fundación Schola Cantorum de Venezuela, directs the Schola Cantorum de Venezuela (since 1992) and Coral Fundación Empresas Polar (since 1992).

The approximately 50-strong *Junges Vokalensemble Hannover* (www.vokalensemble-hannover.de) was founded in 1981 by Prof. Klaus-Jürgen Etzold and has been directed by him ever since. The choir sings a-cappella-music – regularly with world premieres – as well as masses, oratorios and passions through to Ellington's 'Sacred Concerts'. The *Junges Vokalensemble Hannover* has been a studio choir for masterclasses several times, has recorded 17 CDs so far and won a number of prizes at international choir competitions. Concert tours have taken it to almost all European countries as well as countries on all continents, most recently South Africa / Namibia (2015, 2018) and New Zealand / Australia (2023).
